

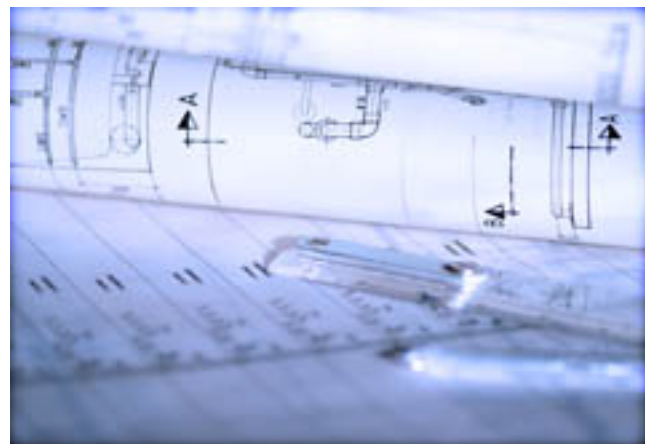
Fire Protection Plan

In the event of an outbreak of fire it is important that the fire service alerted is able to limit the damage as much as possible and quickly extinguish the fire. For this reason, rapid guidance of the fire fighting units to the scene of emergency is necessary.

The fire protection plan is the first line of defence in quickly obtaining necessary information of the fire prevention infrastructure and any hazards at the site.

Because of their special importance to the "operation management" of the attending fire service, fire prevention plans are fundamentally useful and/or mandatory for all "special buildings". In many cases they are also a legal requirement in the course of the construction and commercial negotiations.

In the drawing up of fire protection plans ÖNORM F 2031 (Austrian Standard) and TRVB O 121 must be complied with.



The fire protection plan has to be presented to the local fire service for inspection and approval.

A copy of the fire prevention plan is to be kept by the person responsible for fire prevention in each building, at the main entrance of the fire service and the headquarters of the local fire department.
